Did you know that from January to June 2024, there were 19897 reported fraud cases? The financial losses amounted to \$ 4.48 billion, a significant 66.5% rise from the previous year. The most common victims are students, unemployed individuals, and office workers, highlighting the urgent need for awareness and prevention strategies.

HKPF has been working closely with HKUST to provide extensive anti-fraud education through workshops, emails, and creative projects, delivering vital fraud prevention information to all students over the past years, including an Anti-Scam Online Learning Kit.
