We will organize “**Level 1 & 2 Certificate Course in Dinghy Sailing**” at the Seafront of HKUST. The courses are conducted in English by qualified instructors with lectures and practicum sessions. The necessary equipment will be provided to course participants.

Kindly noted that all participants must be able to swim at least 50 meters. **Students are required to attend the Swimming Proficiency Assessment scheduled at the beginning of the course at the HKUST Outdoor Swimming Pool.**
