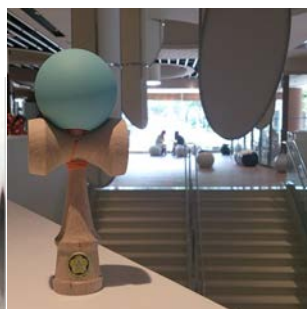
Women in Leadership
